SALMON RECIPE

If you've fished with us already in 2007, or are one of our many guests from the last several years, you left Nootka Wilderness Lodge with some beautiful salmon to enjoy. Try this . . .

Maple-Bourbon Glaze

5t OJ, 1T maple syrup, 1t bourbon, 1/8 t ground red pepper ~ brush over salmon and sprinkle with salt. Place under broiler until salmon flakes easily.

Enjoy with fresh greens or steamed vegetables.
